- The College reopened for staff on 1st June 2017 for the academic year 2017-18 with special Prayer in the chapel evoking God's presence and blessings. The Principal addressed the staff to plan for the academic and Co-curricular activities of the year . Staff Seminar was organized on 1st June 2017 on "The Role of a Teacher in present day Higher Education" and on 2nd June on "Camtasia Studio" and " Mentor-Mentee Relationship".

- On 5th June 2017 the Dept. of Zoology organized reopening day prayer session for all III year students. On 2^{1st} June 2017, the Second year UG students joined back after their II Semester-end break.
- On 21st June 2017 a prayer and welcome programme was organized for the newly joined 1st year UG students and their parents. The Correspondent and the Principal addressed the parents & students focusing on : the Vision and Mission, Core values and objectives, code of conduct, activities, research and project, the role of parents- all leading to the success of the students and the institution. “KNOW YOUR COLLEGE” - a power point presentation on a broad-spectrum of information about the college and its activities enthralled the audience and received excellent feedback from the parents.
- II MBA joined on 7th August, 2017 .
- **Results:** A moment of pride and joy ! We are happy and proud to proclaim that we have achieved 96% pass percentage in UG and PG. BA-96% B.Com- 97% B.Sc.-82% PG 84% and MBA 98%
- **Admissions:** The admissions in 2017-18 have been consistently good with **605** students in first year UG and **112** in PG and **114** in MBA. the total strength of the college is **2160** .
- **Welcomed and introduced to New Faculty!** Nine new faculty members joined the Institution this year in the departments of English, Hindi, Commerce, Psychology, Computer Science, Chemistry and Biochemistry, who were formally welcomed and introduced to the family of St. Pious X on the reopening day by the Principal. The total number of teaching staff **96** and non teaching staff **26** .
- **NAAC-Reaccreditation-2nd Cycle: Marching to reach the goal for excellence.** The college created a hallmark of excellence and quality in the field of education. The college was accredited ‘A’ grade in 2013. Library and Information Science

With a view to enrich the knowledge of the students and to inculcate the habit of reading , the College Library is stocked with around 22000 books, 71 Journals, 08 News Papers and a good collection of CD's and online Journals. The Library is Computerized with Wifi facility and free internet facility with E-Journal packages.

ICT : (Information and Communication Technology)

Information and communication technology is an umbrella term of communication device or applications used extensively by all the departments by recommended by Higher Education. Hi-tech internet enabled computer lab, computer based Communication Lab, LED projectors, Smart Boards, IVR system, Photo Copier, Wi-fi Facility, Open access system, e – Library etc, provided by the Management makes teaching and learning interesting and innovative. ICT also provides more effective means of accessing, communicating and storing information.

Smart Boards and **260** computers have been installed in the college, **200** Computers are under LAN Connection and all Computer Labs are connected to Internet facility. Online assignments are given to the students and the subject material and suggestions are posted online to the students. Many departments are maintaining their Blogs for academic purpose. The classes are provided with LCD Projectors. E- Display boards installed at the lounge gives updated information on the college activities every day.

Continuous Academic Assessment and Evaluation

First and Second Unit Tests and Term Examinations for the academic year 2017-18 were conducted to assess students' academic performance. Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation through assignments, projects, quiz, presentations, online tests, jam, open book, book reviews, working models, literary albums, Viva, group discussions etc keep the students abreast with the curriculum and also regular to the classes.

This year we have conducted two Unit tests, Quarterly and Prefinal theory and practical examinations and two internal assessment tests, followed by Semester exam under CBCS pattern. The schedule of these examinations is well planned and implemented by the **Examination Committee** members.
