POLICY:

Various activities like fund raising, mentoring, career guidance, etc are planned and executed by the association. Report of the same will be presented at the annual general meeting.

- Scholarship: The Alumni contribute significantly towards awarding scholarships to deserving students every year on the college annual day based on the academic performance
- Career Guidance: Alumni are the huge talent pool whose guidance is beneficial to many students and other fellow alumni in their respective areas of study
