MEET, which is an initiative taken to stay in touch with our alumni and to ensure


that our alumni feel connected irrespective of the physical boundaries.




FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION:









2. International Web Conference






3. Career Guidance Program:

4. Interactive Session with Alumni:






