In today’s rapidly changing social landscape, institutions of higher education play a vital role in nurturing responsible, empathetic, and socially aware citizens. With this vision, the AVODAH Committee initiated the **AVODAH Contribution Drive 2025** in collaboration with **Goonj**. The **four-week drive** was designed to instill values of compassion, sustainability, and community service among students by encouraging meaningful contributions and active participation.

Objectives

The primary objectives of the AVODAH Contribution Drive 2025 were:

- To sensitize students towards social responsibility and humanitarian values
- To promote a culture of sharing and collective giving within the campus
- To raise awareness about sustainable practices such as reuse and upcycling
- To educate students on disaster preparedness and community-led support systems
- To strengthen collaboration between educational institutions and social organizations

Activities Conducted during the week:

Inauguration and Launch of the Drive

The Contribution Drive was launched on 20th November 2025 with a Launch & Awareness Day, where faculty and students learned about the initiative and its theme, “One Campus, One Heart — Together We Give,” inspiring active participation.

Materials Collected During the Contribution Drive

During the AVODAH Contribution Drive 2025, the college community collected a wide range of **urgently needed old but usable and new materials** to support disaster relief and community welfare initiatives in collaboration with Goonj.

The collected materials included clothing and textiles; food and essential supplies; footwear; medicines and medical equipment; toiletries and cleaning supplies; household utensils; toys; electronics and office equipment (in working condition); furniture; educational materials; and other utility items such as umbrellas, raincoats, buckets, suitcases, and sewing machines.

Awareness and Outreach Activities

Awareness was promoted through announcements, student interactions, and campus radio updates, ensuring wide outreach and active participation.

Creative and Experiential Learning Activities

An impactful **Creative & Awareness Activity** was conducted on **12th December 2025**, focusing on experiential learning and student expression.

Open Mic & Music for a Cause

Students showcased their talents through poems, songs, and short narratives that highlighted themes of empathy, kindness, and social commitment. This platform encouraged emotional expression and helped participants connect deeply with the purpose of the drive.

Upcycling Workshop

A hands-on upcycling workshop promoted sustainable living, where students transformed old clothes, books, paper, and plastic into useful products, encouraging responsible consumption and environmental awareness.

Special Initiative: Disaster Awareness Exhibition

As a significant extension of the drive, **Goonj** organized a **Disaster Awareness Exhibition** on campus. The exhibition provided students with valuable insights into:

- The realities and challenges faced during natural and man-made disasters
- Common misconceptions related to disaster relief
- The importance of preparedness, dignity, and community participation

This initiative enhanced students’ understanding of grassroots-level disaster management and the role of collective action in times of crisis.

Student Engagement and Leadership

Students from all UG and PG programs actively participated in organizing and conducting the activities, enhancing their leadership, teamwork, communication skills, and sense of social responsibility.

Outcomes and Impact

- Enhanced awareness about social issues and disaster preparedness
- Increased student involvement in community service initiatives
- Development of sustainable practices through upcycling activities
- Strengthened partnership between the college and Goonj
- Creation of a compassionate campus culture rooted in collective action

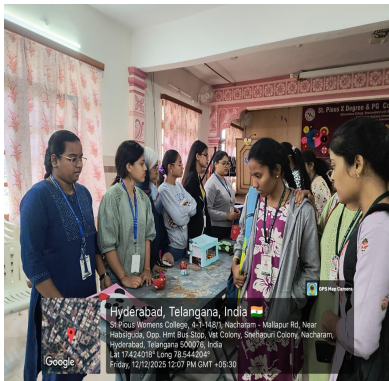
