
CAPBILITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMMES – 2020 - 2021

11-09-2020: REPORT ON "HEALTH DIET: IMMUNITY" (RIGHT FOOD BRIGHT LIFE)



15-09-2020: REPORT ON WEBINAR ON "BEING STRONGER FOR TOGETHER"








17-09-2020: REPORT ON ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON "ONLINE TALLY COURSE"

28-09-2020: REPORT ON WEBINAR SERIES ON "RIGHT FOOD – BRIGHT LIFE"




19 & 20-11-2020: REPORT ON RESUME WRITING

The speaker has given all the in and out of the resume with several tips like using effective titles, proofreading twice, using bullet points etc. He emphasized on the importance of



11 & 12-12-2020: REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL WEB-SERIES ON "DIGITAL DISRUPTION"










15-12-2020: REPORT ON WEBINAR ON "THE HYGIENE'S OF WRITTEN COMMUNICATION"

19-12-2020: REPORT ON WEBINAR ON "LEADERSHIP ENGINEERING – A NEW GENERATION CONCEPT"






07 & 08-1-2021: REPORT ON SESSION ON SKILLING TO COMMUNICATE

Conference Organizing Secretary Mrs. Monoshri Mitra, HOD, English, gave the Significance of the Conference -to bring forth the very latest findings before they are even published in journals by addressing many aspects of communication, oral and written, and explore the possibility of a comprehensive English language curriculum beneficial for graduating students who face challenges in communication in the professional context. Conference Chairman Rev. Sr. Velangini, Principal, stated the objective of the Conference, to learn from expert speakers, panelists, session chairs, faculty, students, She welcomed all the participants to active interaction and exchange of ideas and motivated everyone by saying that there's no better chance to get one's work placed in front of specialists and have them candidly discuss strengths and weaknesses of new ideas. Conference Chief Guest Dr. C. Murali Krishna, Prof and Head, Dept. of English, Osmania University, stressed on the point that all four skills of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing are required to be proficient in a language. SESSION 1

Conference Key Note Speaker Dr. Hema Ramanathan, Author and Teacher Educator, University of West Georgia, addressed the audience on the topic "ORAL AND WRITTEN COMMUNICATION IN ENGLISH FOR PROFESSIONAL PURPOSES – FRAMING THE DISCOURSE". She explained and demonstrated that while English is increasingly significant for

advancement in the world of work, young professionals in India demonstrate a decreasing proficiency level in both oral and written communication. Faculty of various technical and business programs often complain about the inability of students to perform academic and professional tasks in English. Faculty in English departments struggle to address student academic and professional needs. Further, the distinctions between oral and written communication skills at this level of education are mainly reflected in the curriculum in terms of genres.

SESSION 2

Lead talk by Dr. Lina Mukhopadhyay, Prof and Head, Dept of Training and Development, English Language Education, Second Language Acquisition, Faculty Member, The English and Foreign Languages University, talked on "USING TECHNOLOGY TO DEVELOP AND ASSESS COLLEGE WRITING". She emphasized that we must understand the importance of using academic language for college writing to complete a variety of tasks such as essays, assignments and reports. CEFR based standards of development of academic writing skill, which is a higher-order cognitive-linguistic skill, can be taken up at the threshold level (B1) followed by the use of Web 2.0 tools to practise collaborative writing by engaging with social writing tools like wikis, meeting spaces and chatboxes. Collaborative writing can be self-assessed using technology or automatic writing evaluator (AWE) to get feedback on writing and develop the skill.

SESSION 3

Lead Talk by Mr. Seth Koshy, Business coach, Venture Capitalist and Investor, USA spoke on "LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION IN SUCCESSFUL ENTREPRENEURSHIP" - the problems and risks involved and how to take them to become successful. All the participants involved in an active interactive session and clarified their queries. The talk explored the Importance of mastering English, Problem solving, Taking calculated risks, Networking constantly, opening up to different experiences and Balance are the core subjects in good communication. The communicator has to keep in mind that "Everything is a sale (interview, to choosing a movie), Communicate effectively helps in every sale, Reach a consensus, Appear more capable and Focus on the positives."

Lead Talk by Dr. Sailaja, Head, Talent Development, Ramky Enviro Engineers lmt, Learning and development manager, Telangana Academy of Skill and Knowledge, Hyd. Talked on "SOFT SKILLS IN LITERARY TEXTS". She said that Literature serves two important purposes. One is to give enjoyment, and other is to instruct. That is, Art is for Art's sake as well as for society's sake. Not only the modern literature, but the ancient literature also strongly believed that literature should play key role in taking care of social welfare, social transformation and societal progress. Though the mode of transformation aspired or visualized by the ancient writers relatively differ based on the circumstances in which they lived, fundamentally both agreed upon the utility value of literature. That is why, Nannayya, who is considered as Adi Kavi (first poet) in Telugu, first of the trio who translated Mahabharata into Telugu, said in his Andhra Sabdha Chintamani, "Viswa Sreyah Kavyam" – meaning 'Literary work's main purpose is universal welfare' Whether it is Sanskrit, English, Telugu or any other language, the main objectives of teaching language and literature are: (i) to help the students learn and use the language; (ii) to help them relish the literature (to take pleasure in literature); and (iii) to teach useful things for betterment in their life."
