
CAPABILITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME 2021-2022

19-06-2021: "WEBINAR ON HOW TO BE AN EFFICIENT LEARNER"



28-06-2021: "Session on Substance Abuse & its Impact on Health"




28-07-2021: "Webinar on GAFAM's Power: Political Economy Governmentality in Digital Capitalism"

Session 1 was given by Dr.Ramjee Pallela, Chief Operating Officer, ATAL Incubation Centre-CCMB, Hyderabad on the topic "Entrepreneurship Opportunities In Emerging Areas Of Applied Biosciences." He emphasized that the research works should involve not only exploratory works but also translational which have great scope of funding by innovation grants to pave a path for marketable products and processes. He mentioned about several funding opportunities that have come up to support not only the startups but also the academic and non-academic innovators to complete the journey from ideation to commercialization such as BIRAC, DBT, DST, NITIAAYOG etc.

After Lunch break, there were oral paper presentations which were scheduled in 2 tracks via online platforms. The Chair persons for the oral sessions were Dr.Sreedevi, Head, Dept of Microbiology and Dr.Kiranmayee, Faculty, Dept. of Biochemistry. A total of 34 Papers were presented by delegates on on diverse areas of applied biosciences. The Judges were Dr.A.Vimala Rodhe, Head, Dept. Of Microbiology, Siver Jubilee Govt. Degree College, Kurnool and Dr.Vindhya Vasini Roy, Former Head, Dept of Microbiology, St.Pious X Degree and PG College for Track 1 and Dr.K.S.N.Jyothi for Track 2 and declared best papers.

The next day's program i.e on 4td September 2021 started at 9.30AM with welcome note by Mrs. Pritha Ghosh followed by session 2 by Dr. S. Venkata Mohan, Senior Principal Scientist, Bioengineering and Environmental Sciences Lab, Department of Energy and Environmental Engineering, CSIR-Indian Institute of Chemical Technology (CSIR-IICT) on the topic "Waste Fed Biorefineries For Biobased Chemical And Fuels." He focussed on the

importance of biogenic materials as potential feedstock that needsto be transformed into a source of value through biorefineries. He discussed on the concept of circular economy (CE) that focuses on the reuse and recycling of materials in technical and biological cycles to reduce waste generation is a critical intervention.

This was followed by session 3 delivered by Dr. Annamma Anil Odaneth, Associate Professor, Centre of Energy Biosciences, Institute of Chemical Technology, Mumbai on the topic "Enzyme Technology for Biofuel and Biochemical Processes." She spoke on recent advances in protein engineering, whole genome engineering and metabolic engineering that allowed the design of optimal enzyme systems and their applications as biocatalysts for fine and bulk manufacturing of products, thereby paving the route for a biobased circular economy.

This was followed by Poster presentation session which was scheduled in 2 parallel tracks via online platforms. The Chair persons for the poster sessions were Ms.C.Vanisree, Head, Dept of Biochemistry and Ms.Pritha Ghosh, Faculty, Dept. of Microbiology. 


06-12-2021: REPORT ON "A GLOBAL CONCERN COVID-19 VARIANT: OMICRON"

The Department of Microbiology in collaboration with Abhignya Biotechnology consultants organized a guest lecture on "A Global Concern COVID-19 Variant: Omicron" on 6th December 2021. The Resource person for the day was Dr. Samatha Tulla, M.D (Internal medicine).

The speaker discussed principal concerns about Omicron, whether it is more infectious or severe than other Variants of concern and whether it can circumvent vaccine protection. 09-12-2021: "Session on Solid Waste Management"





various innovative ways to enhance their career. More than 100 students of various streams of Life sciences attended the webinar.




04-02-2022: "Session on Endometriosis and Cancer Risk"

21-03-2022: "COURSE ON TALLY"






