# Admission Procedure

## Under Graduate Programmes

For admission into Under Graduate programs, the students should have passed two year Intermediate Examination or Central Board of Secondary Education or an examination recognized and considered equivalent by Board of Intermediate T.S. The students from other states should produce eligibility certificate issued by the Board of Intermediate at the time of Admission.

For admission into B.A., B.Com, B.B.A and B.Sc., the candidate should have secured at least 60% of the aggregate marks in Intermediate or equivalent examination and 50% in the concerned subject.

Students seeking admission into this college are not eligible for applying for Scholarship and fee reimbursement provided by Govt. of Telangana as the college is not in DOST (Degree Online Services, Telangana)

The College being a Minority Institution gives preference to minority candidates. The nonminority candidates are admitted on merit basis.

Admission into sports quota is given to the distinguished candidates at State or National level. Relevant certificates issued by the competent authority should be submitted along with the application forms.

The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from a Foreign University should submit all the relevant information/ documents, and all original certificates along with the approval Letter of Admission by Osmania University.

## Post Graduate Programmes

For admission into Post Graduate courses, the students should have passed three year under graduate course with the respective subject from any recognized University.

The students should also qualify the CPGET/ICET Entrance Examination conducted by Osmania University in the concerned subject.

The eligible candidates shall be admitted through counselling conducted by Osmania University.

## College Fee

The College is a self-financed Institution.

Fee should be paid at the beginning of every Semester through online.

Fee once paid is neither refunded nor transferred.

# The Departments



## DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The St. Pious X College Department of English was established in 1993 with General English for B.A, B.Com & B.Sc. Modern Language (English) was introduced in 1994. Seven competent and vivacious faculty members with innovative minds aim at enabling the students to realize that the lessons in the curriculum are also lessons for life. The faculty takes keen interest to enhance communication skills of the students for global competency, create and strengthen aesthetic sense through language and literature. 100% result is the outstanding feature of the department. 7 University gold medals, 19 top rankers and 85% distinction highlight the academic excellence of the department and achievements of the students. The Department takes pride that majority of the students go for B.Ed, P.G, M.Phil and PhD in the premiere Institutions in and out of India and others excel in their career in the reputed organizations.

Communication Lab (estd. 2005) with 20 systems, 40 headphones and 60 audio practice CDs train the students in aural and oral skills in English to improve their pronunciation, accent, intonation and vocabulary and prepare them to fare well in their job interviews. The department reinforces Listening, Speaking, and Reading & Writing skills by organizing seminars, workshops, presentations, career guidance and field trips and prepares the students of various streams to face challenges in life. It also serves as a channel to cultivate a value-added life and achieve quality in higher education through its departmental library, Johnson's literary club activities, book reviews, projects, film shows, film-making, dramatics, Rhythm of Life and Out Cry musical concerts and counseling.

The dept. offers Bridge Course in Grammar, Literature and Communicative English to B.A, B.Sc and B.Com students and Interdisciplinary course on 'Functional English' to P.G students. It has collaboration with Across the Monde for a Diploma in Travel and Tourism and offers the course to the interested students to take up Air line jobs. It also has an MOU with 'Learners circle' and conducts Employability Skill development programme – "Grooming for Growth" to the students equipping them with communication skills and career opportunities to excel in life. Visiting orphanages and donating basic needs inculcate a sense of Social Responsibility among the students.

## DEPARTMENT OF SECOND LANGUAGES

Hindi, Telugu & Sanskrit are offered as second languages. Well-experienced and highly qualified faculty members handle the department. Apart from regular teaching, the department conducts Seminars, Literary Quiz, Translation, Group discussions and Mini projects. The department takes keen interest in helping the students to participate in the various cultural activities exhibiting their talent and creativity. Securing 100% result is the unique feature of the department. The department takes up community development services through street plays on social themes. The department of Hindi runs literary and cultural club by name “PRATHIBHA” and brings out annual magazine in Hindi.

## DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

The faculty of Political Science, Public Administration, Economics, Psychology and Mass Communication constitute the department of Social Sciences. The department was started in 1993 with a vision to enrich the knowledge, develop self - confidence and self – esteem of the students and to understand and analyse the various aspects of the society. The department strongly believes that a vibrant, goal oriented development requires a healthy interaction between individual, society and state. To provide the Socio-Political consciousness among the students, the department regularly organizes debates and seminars on contemporary issues. The inter-disciplinary courses give a strong base to the students, and also help them to comprehend the various Socio-Political and economic problems of the society. The department of Psychology and Mass Communication have a well-equipped laboratories for the practical knowledge of the subjects. The department promotes culture of excellence concern for social equity, social dedication and social responsibility. **The department has bagged 6 Gold Medals to its credit.**

## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

Commerce Department is one of the largest departments in the college. The department has the distinction of securing 100% pass percentage for several years. It always stood in **the first five positions among the University colleges** for securing high pass percentage and maximum number of first classes in the public exams. To keep pace with the modern trends ICT based teaching is adopted. The department has large class rooms,





furnished with LCD's and well equipped computer labs with free internet facility. It has a Commerce lab and a departmental Library. Workshops and seminars are organized on a regular basis to keep the students abreast with latest trends in the field of Commerce. **It offers CAT – Certified Accounting Technician course recognized by ICWAI.** It also conducts Money Olympiad in association with Money Wizards, Chennai. Under the Banner of SPOORTHY CLUB, the department organizes inter-collegiate competitions in Group discussion, Case Study, PPT, Poster presentation, etc. on a regular basis. Industrial tours and field trips are arranged to expose the students to the corporate world. Coaching facility is made available for ICET, SAP and Bank PO exams & Campus recruitment. Majority of the students are placed in well reputed companies.

## DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

The department known for excellence, creativity and innovation is in existence since 1993. The well qualified, dedicated and competent faculty, teach the latest trends in animal sciences. It conducts seminars, guest lectures, field trips, exhibitions and projects. The Dept. promotes institution neighborhood work through projects and surveys on Healthy living for better society. The department has a well - equipped museum and well established library. It has strong Linkages at State, National and International level and the students actively involve in various club activities and inhouse projects. The department also offers certificate courses in Food and Nutrition and M.L.T (Medical Laboratory Techniques). The faculty publishes Research papers in National and International Journals. **It also has the credit of achieving 7 University top ranks.**

## DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

The department of Computer Science has qualified and dedicated faculty. It focuses on empowering students with competence in theoretical knowledge, programming languages, communication skills, team work and holistic development of the students. The students take up practicals in 5 Air conditioned Laboratories on highly configured systems.

The department is dedicated to make the entire campus computer friendly by offering basics in computers to teaching, non-teaching faculty and non-computer students. It conducts various

advanced programmes for staff. It conducts various certificate and diploma courses in advanced computer technology for students. It is a highly innovative department wherein the students are trained to do project work and paper presentations. It has established strong linkage with industry and invites various companies to recruit the students to be placed in reputed companies. Many of the students stood as top rankers in B.Sc stream. The department is active in conducting and evaluating online feedback system and update the college website.

## DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

The department was established in the year 1993 and has the distinction of having well experienced and highly qualified faculty with Ph.D. degree. The department is equipped with spacious laboratory with latest equipment. The departmental library has good collection of books and journals for the use of students and staff. The department organises various environmental programmes and health awareness activities. It also offers job oriented certificate course in Medical Coding. Consistent excellence in the public examinations of Osmania University is hall mark of the department. It has the credit of producing University Topper with gold medal in Botany and also features almost every year in the Toppers list of the O.U.

## DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

The department has good infrastructure as well as experienced teaching faculty. It is committed to generate excellence in basic techniques required for biotechnology research and for placements in various biotech labs. It conducts workshops in which students have hands on experience in doing projects. To enhance the quality in teaching, the faculty use various ICT based methods. It organizes guest lectures, seminars and workshops. It trains the students on project work and provides career guidance and counseling. The department has **the credit of achieving 10 University top ranks.**

## DEPARTMENT OF GENETICS

Department of Genetics has a fully equipped and a well-furnished spacious laboratory. The laboratory is specialized in conducting Molecular Biology experiments with the help of





Electrophoretic apparatus, Micropipettes and Chromatography chamber etc. Participating in various debates, symposia and workshops is a regular feature. The department is innovative in assigning research projects to students to acquaint them with scientific proceedings.

## DEPARTMENT OF STATISTICS

The department of statistics was established in the year 2000 with the combination of Mathematics and Computer Science. Since its inception, the department has been achieving 100% results with 90% distinctions in the public examinations. The significance of the department lies in group discussions, seminars, quiz competitions and statistical surveys. The department encourages students to come together and organize Inter- collegiate competitions and work on projects. It has a well-established departmental library.

## DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS

The Mathematics department was started in the year 1993 at the undergraduate level and M.Sc Mathematics was introduced in 2006. It lays emphasis on the power and attractiveness of the subject, which is often hidden from students with a scope that has revolutionized mathematics learning through various extension lectures delivered by eminent Professors. Regular tests, Group discussions, Quiz and Seminar are the powerful tools that enable students to visualize, explore and understand Mathematics as never before. Students finding good placement in various fields and 90% of the students join P.G course in the prestigious Institutes in India and abroad. The secret behind this success lies in the hands of dedicated, hard working and encouraging staff members. The SIGMA club activities like seminars and exhibitions provide a platform for students to bring their innate talents and innovative ideas to the forefront.

## DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS

Established in the year 1993. The department of physics is full-fledged with well-equipped six laboratories. It has instruments like GM counters, high resolution spectrometers etc. The department provides superb environment to study Physics. While functioning within the frame

work of University syllabus, it thrusts on practical applications in the field of Physics. Class room teaching is supplemented with lectures from eminent professors, scientists and directors of research laboratories. The department has a track record of **securing 4 gold medals for scoring highest marks at University level and also secured many ranks at UG and PG levels.** It offers M.Sc Physics with Electronics and Instrumentation as specialization.

**Equipment and Apparatus provided:** The department has well-equipped laboratories with all basic amenities. Highly sensitive instruments like Michelson Interferometer, Spectrometers and Calorimeters are setup in the labs. Electronics labs have microprocessors, CROs and Micro Controllers.

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## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The department of Chemistry was started in the year 1993 at under graduate level and M.Sc. Chemistry was introduced in 2005. The faculty is highly creative and innovative to design new instructional methodology. It is rated as one of the best department for practical approach and inculcating aptitude for research among students. Offering remedial classes for the weak students and special quality instruction to the talented students is the part of the curricular activity of the department. It promotes research culture among the students by giving those projects, seminars and paper presentations. Getting the gold medal in chemistry is a regular feature of the department.

**Equipment and Apparatus provided:** The Laboratories are spacious and well ventilated, conducive for learning. They are provided with all Chemicals and apparatus required for practical and project works. The instrumentation room is provided with UV - Visible Spectrophotometer, Colorimeter, Digital Balances, Hot Air Ovens, Centrifuge Machines, Melting point apparatus, pH. Meters, Polarimeters, Conductometers, Vacuum Pump and Potentiometer and a special research laboratory to undertake project work by staff and students.





## DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

The department was established in 1995 and M.Sc. Biochemistry course was started in 2002. It has efficient faculty with experienced research and industry. The department organizes seminar on various topics and prepares the students for projects, workshops, group discussion and paper presentations. National seminars, guest lectures by subject experts, field trips to reputed Institutions like CCMB, ICRISAT, IKP, Agree Biotech etc., are organised regularly. The department has a student - teacher association named Biomystery Club which conducts extension activities, community development programmes and also promotes scientific temper of the students through various competitions. It has the distinction of sending the students for pursuing research at National and International Institutions and has the **credit of securing 4 Gold Medals and 27 top ranks at the University level**. It takes the pride of 100% pass percentage and more than 50% of Distinctions every year. **The alumni are well placed in reputed research Institutions like IICT, CCMB, NIT, NIN etc.**

### Equipment and Apparatus provided:

The M.Sc. Biochemistry labs are well-equipped with necessary and sophisticated instruments like U.V. Spectrophotometer, Cooling centrifuges, Fluorimeter, Flame Photometer, pH meters, Calorimeters, Fume Chambers, PCR machine, Chromatograph chambers, Rota mixers, High speed Centrifuges, Micro pipettes etc. The department is conducive for Research activities and internal projects are being carried out regularly.

## DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY

The Department of Microbiology was established in the year 1994 and upgraded with the introduction of P.G. course in the year 2000. The mission of the department aims at excellence in the field of Microbiology and prepares professionally competent individuals. The vision of the department is to inspire, motivate and emerge young women with more vibrant entrepreneurial culture and enhance their scientific aptitude. One of the distinguishing characteristics of the department its excellent infrastructure with sophisticated laboratories equipped with modern instruments. The infrastructure provides the students with the ambience necessary for them to understand and practice advanced techniques in Microbiology. The members of the faculty have continued their impressive accomplishments as leaders in their respective fields and have engineered the success of the Department. To

enhance the quality in teaching, faculty uses various ICT based methods. The success rate is consistent through all the academic years with 80-90% pass percentage in UG and 100% results among the Post Graduates with 40-50% of distinctions. **The department has a track record of achieving 18 top ranks in the university P.G. Examinations.**

The department organizes subject expert talks, career counseling, industrial visits, symposia, workshops and conferences on a regular basis. The department has to its credit of organizing an International Conference ICMAES 2016 for the first time in the College. The department has an active students club "SARCINA" which promote students interest and involves them in advancing their scientific knowledge through personal interaction and competitions.

#### **Equipment and Apparatus Provided:**

The department of Microbiology has an excellent infrastructure with three well equipped labs and an instrumentation room. The laboratories have all the basic instruments like Autoclaves, Incubators, Hot Air Ovens, Magnetic Stirrers, Microscopes, Colorimeters, Single Pan and Digital balances. The instrumentation room houses sophisticated instruments viz. Lyophilizer, Gel Documentation Unit, Deep Freezer, Phase Contrast Microscope, High Speed Cooling Centrifuge, Microfuge, Tissue homogenizer, BOD Incubator, Shaking Incubator, Electrophoresis Units and UV Transilluminator.

### **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

The department of Physical education was established in the year 2005, run by well qualified, dedicated and efficient faculty who strive to cater the needs and enhance the overall personality development of the students. The department is well equipped with sufficient indoor hall, gymnasium and play ground. It offers indoor and outdoor games like Basket Ball, Kho-Kho, Kabbadi, Volley Ball, Shuttle, Badminton, Tenni-koit, Chess, Carroms and Athletics. In addition to this, it conducts fitness programmes that reduce the physical and mental stress and also motivates the students to face highly competitive sports and world, in the midst of revolution of rising expectations and ambition of projecting their best performance in intra, inter-college, national and international level with Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.





## LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE

St. Pious X Degree and P.G College for Women is facilitated with three libraries each for UG established in the year 1993, PG in 2002 and MBA in 2009 with adequate facilities and services to achieve the Institutional Objectives.

The library is spacious, well ventilated with hybrid collection and has qualified, trained and dedicated staff to provide the state of art information technology for the use of Online and Physical resources. Biometric method is followed to calculate per day usage of library. Closed Circuit Cameras are installed to safe guard the library resources.

The department has state of the art facilities and is equipped with ICT enabled classrooms, high end studio and a media lab. 

# Evaluation Pattern for CBCS

## (Choice Based Credit System)

**C**hoice Based Credit System (CBCS): Osmania University has implemented CBCS structure for its Under Graduate and Post Graduate programs from the academic year 2016-17. It is a semester based scheme in which every student has to get a minimum score (40%) to get promoted to the next semester.

- Each course will have 100 marks per semester
  - 20 marks for internals
  - 80 marks for end semester exam
- Two Internals assessments per course
- 15 marks each (average to be given)
- 1 assignment of 5 marks
- No retest
- 3 hours semester Annual exam per course
- Pass percentage = 40% (both internals and semester exam put together)
- No Part I and Part II separation in final results
- English, Second Language, SEC (Skill Enhancement Course), GE (Generic Elective) and Options will all be included in SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average) and CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average).
- Memo will display Credits and Grades per course per semester. No marks will be indicated in the memo

Unit tests and term examinations are conducted periodically to monitor the students' academic performance is sent to the parents through SMS. The Examination Committee plans for Unit tests, Internal Examination, and Pre-final theory and practical examinations for all the students. Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation through assignments, projects, quiz, presentations, online test, JAM, open book, models, book reviews, albums, Viva, Objective Type questions, Group discussion etc. keep the students always alert with their curriculum and regular to the classes.

### Code of Conduct

1. Students are expected to dress up in simple and decent manner which conforms to the standards of modesty. Sleeveless, short tops, Low waist jeans and tight garments are not allowed.
2. They should behave politely and respectfully and abide by the rules and regulations stipulated by the college from time to time.

7. Ragging is totally prohibited in and out side the campus and also in the hostel. Strict action shall be initiated against the students who indulge in ragging and anti- social activities.





- 75% of attendance in every semester is compulsory to be eligible to write internals and end semester examinations.
