## COLLEGE ANNUAL REPORT - 2013-2014

St. Pious X Degree and PG college has completed 20 fruitful years for the cause of Women education. The College is a Self Financed Institution established in 1993, affiliated to Osmania University. It is **accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC** and recognized by UGC with **2 (F) and 12 (B)**. It is a moment of joy for me to share the progress and achievements of the college for the year 2013-2014. At this moment, I would like to express my gratitude to all great women in the past who rendered tireless and dedicated services to make St. Pious X College what is today. I believe that this report reflects our identity as an institution and presents a clear road map for St. Pious future.

### Profile of the College:

The vision of the college is **empowering women through holistic education, enable them to function effectively as competent, socially committed and compassionate individuals**. When it was established in 1993 it had a meager strength of 90 students on roll in three disciplines of BA, B.Com & B.Sc which has now increased significantly to 1575 . The college has been putting on new shoots every year by adding new departments regularly and grown to a sizeable institution with 14 under graduate programs and 5 Post graduate courses in M.Sc. – Microbiology, Biochemistry, Chemistry , Physics and Business Management ( MBA). This year we have introduced BA Mass Communication with Psychology & English Literature. We are also offering 08 Certificate courses and 01 Diploma course under value added and career oriented programs. **77** Teaching and **36** Non Teaching staff are extending their dedicated services for the all-round development of the students.

**The following are some of the goals and objectives of the institution:** The institution aims at preparing the graduates to lead extraordinary lives in pursuit of truth, Personal integrity, ethical behavior and care for others.



1. The under graduate and post graduate curricula encourage creative thought ethical behavior, respect for diversity and all -round development. **Quality consciousness, innovation, sensitivity and service are the core values of the college.** We believe that the educational institutions have multiple roles to play. Hence St. Pious develops a scientific mind with social consciousness, making the student a complete and perfect individual .Therefore we have set in certain goals this year :

- To introduce job oriented and need based certificate courses and interdisciplinary subjects at under graduate level.
- To introduce new courses to fulfill the demand of the nation.

#### **NAAC Accreditation:**

The college went for NAAC accreditation in September, 2012. A three member team visited St. Pious College from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2012. The college thanks the team members for their appreciation and guidance. The college was accredited with ‘A’ grade with CGPA 3.16 on a four point scale for a period of five years on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2013..

The NAAC peer team visit was a momentous event in the history of the College. The NAAC team was headed by **Prof. G. Pankajam**– Chairperson, NAAC, **Dr Sr. Doris D’Souza** – Member coordinator and **Prof D. Nussy**, Member visited the campus during 13-15<sup>th</sup> Septembr 2012.

The Principal Rev Dr Sr Nirmala, presented the Executive Summary of the college through Ppt. The report included day to day administration of the College, Planning and Execution of all academic programs (Almanac), collaborations with industries, implementation of the Management policies, Co-curricular activities and Extension services, Academic enrichment of the faculty and All-round achievements of the students. The NAAC team congratulated the Principal for the successful progression of the Institution at both administrative and academic levels. It was followed by Internal Quality Assurance Committee report presented by the Coordinator Mrs Grace Beena Paul, Head, Department of Zoology. The souvenir of IQAC was released by the NAAC team. They were impressed by the IQAC report and suggested to organize student exchange



programs at International level and develop more tie-ups with International agencies.

The departmental visits by the NAAC Peer team, a luncheon meeting with Governing Body members, representatives from Management, Academic Advisory Committee members, faculty and student representatives, interaction with parents, alumni and students followed by a cultural show were some of the Highlights of the visit. The team also observed the Infrastructural and other Facilities provided to students viz., Auditorium, sports facilities, Students' rest room, Hostel, Guest room, NSS, Gym, Placements, NCC, Counseling facility, AICUF and PEARL. They also assessed Office Administration and interacted with Non-teaching and Technical staff of the College.

The Chairperson of NAAC peer team Prof G. Pankajam presented the NAAC report to the Staff, Management and the Student Council Members in the Exit Meeting. She appreciated the Management and Staff for their dedicated services for empowering women through quality education. Rev Sr. Rose Lynda, the Superior General of Catechist Sisters of St Ann also addressed the gathering and thanked the NAAC peer team. A vote of thanks was proposed by Mrs Sandhyasree, NAAC Coordinator, St. Pious X College for Women.

The academic year 2013-2014 began on 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2013 with a meaningful Prayer session, invoking God's assistance and blessings. Under the guidance of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, the dept of Arts conducted "**Faculty Orientation Program**" on 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 on "**Teacher Beyond Curriculum**" by Dr. Beena, Head, Dept. of Psychology and Director of Indian Council of Social Science Research, Mr. Satyanarayana, Swami Vivekananda Institute of Human Excellence and Prof. ML Sai Kumar, Institute of Public Enterprise, Hyderabad.

**New Appointments :-** .During this academic year as many as 09 Teaching Staff have been recruited in Undergraduate & Post Graduate sections.

**Admissions & Students Strength :-** The admission process for the year 2013-2014 was carried out with Professional competence. The online facility for admissions made the admission process easy. Foreign students are admitted every year through UFRO of Osmania



University. Students from China, Syria, Iraq, Yemen, Tanzania and Vietnam are studying in our college this year.



For the current year 2013-2014 the total strength of the college is 1575.

- Remedial classes are organized in various subjects in view of helping the students who are weak in studies. Bright students are provided with extra information and additional material is provided to satisfy their intellectual zeal.
- Nearly, 2/3 of our passed out students enroll for higher studies. The Post graduate students are encouraged to take up research. Few students are working in Prestigious Laboratories in India and Abroad. All the students are encouraged to do Project works.

St. Pious X College has adapted various initiatives to improve the quality of education. The hard work and dedication of the staff and students produce excellent results year after year. In keeping with past record, last year's results too were very good. The management awards the students meritorious who score 90% above marks in Public examination with special cash prizes.

#### **Academic Laurels:**

The college has recorded significant progress in academic pursuits by way of its programme of teaching, research and extension activities. If the results alone indicate quality of the college then the success rate of the students in University examinations will surely elevate our institution as a centre of excellence.

The results of the college for the year 2012-2013:

**UG level:** BA secured 100 % pass B.Com 90%, B.Sc. 92% ,

**PG level:** MBA -100% , M.Sc. Physics – 96%, Biochemistry 92% , M.Sc.

Microbiology 90% , M.Sc. – Chemistry 75%

Achieving the ranks in Osmania University is a regular feature of the college. This year we have achieved two Gold Medals in BA English Literature and M.Sc. Biochemistry. With this the total number of gold medals increased to 25 for the past 19 years.

**IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) :** The Internal Quality Assurance Cell embarked initiative consciously and consistently to ensure excellence in the academic and non-academic programme offerings of the college . IQAC has been primarily responsible for various quality enhancement initiatives. Some of the significant contributions of IQAC are

  - Organizing of a short course in advance topics in Computer Science.
  - Organizing various Certificate Courses for all the degree students.
  - Organizing various educational fests and events .
  - Organizing faculty development seminars and workshops

### **Infrastructural Improvement : 2013-2014**

- A spacious indoor games room was constructed.
- Gym Room is also provided.
- Additional Conference Hall is established.
- Having applied for NAAC accreditation, all the buildings on the campus will be painted in the month of January.
- Basket ball court is renovated with application of professional technology.
- Second Mineral Water Plant is provided on the main block of the college and water coolers are purchased to fix on every floor of the building.
- 10 LCD Projectors are fixed in class rooms.
- A smart interactive electronic board is provided in the conference room.
- Parking shed for students is provided.
- The Internal main road of the college will be repaired with pavement tiles in January.
- Library has been fully automated with networking of 3 libraries.

### **Library:**

It has been the policy of the college and my Predecessor Rev.Sr.Regina to set in the academic soundness of an educational institution that is reflected in a well equipped library. There are three libraries separately for UG, PG and MBA courses connected with intranet. They are fully automated with reprographic facilities and has 20,150 books, 70 Print journals and 03 E-Journals and four data bases namely EBESCO, Business Source Elite, J-Gate Social and Management sciences and N-List from INFIBNET. We can browse nearly 8000 e-Journals from these databases. They can allow full text articles, e-books, company profiles and tutorials for faculty, i.e., video lessons. We have been over the years strengthening the



library by purchasing books, reference books and subscribing National and International Journals in many disciplines. We have the facility to access the E-Library and every student is provided with E-Password. The library has a free Book Bank and it works from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on all working days. Every year library week is celebrated and students present project reports and survey reports.

### **ICT Learning Resources:**

The college has taken special interest in Tech support teaching. Smart Boards and 230 computers have been installed in the college, 179 Computers are under LAN Connection and all Computer Labs are connected to Internet facility. MBA Lab has Wi-Fi facility.


The Faculty assigns online assignments to the students and also post the subject notes and suggestions online to the students. Many departments are maintaining their Blogs for academic purpose. All the MBA and M. Sc and a few under graduate classes are provided with LCD Projectors. E- Display boards are also installed at the lounge and gives updated information on the college activities every day.

The college conducts in house exams and communicates the performance of the students to the parents online.

**Evaluation & Remedial Classes :-** To monitor the continuous progress of the students, the college has adopted various methods to assess the students' performance through test, seminars, workshops, group discussions and assignments. Special coaching is given to the weak students. Regular internal tests and terminal examinations are conducted and marks are sent to the parents online.

The Depts. Of Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Statistics, Computer Science, Commerce, Public Administration, Political Science, English & Microbiology and Zoology gave remedial classes to 190 students of II & III year of B.A, B.Com & B.Sc who needed special guidance and support to pass the supplementary exams. The remedial classes were conducted for about two months and the students have achieved successful result of 100% pass %.

**Parents' Orientation on "Role of Parents in shaping the youth" by Dr. Ratnakar, Global Hospitals:** Since the parents are main stakeholders of the college and their



collaboration is imperative, an orientation for the parents of Degree 1<sup>st</sup> year students was conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2013. Mr. Ratnakar , from Global Hospitals was the resource person for the occasion. He urged the parents to take care of over- all well being of their children and thereby ensuring a better society to live.

The teachers discussed the personality and academic progress of the students with the parents and the feedback of the parents on the quality of education, discipline and other aspects was welcomed.

**Skill based certificate courses** :- Skill-based inter disciplinary certificate courses are offered to I year students in Beauty-Culture, Food and Nutrition, Multi-Media, Web Designing and Painting. The classes for these courses were conducted over a month's time commencing from 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2013.

A 30 hour certificate course on Quality control in Microbiology was started in collaboration with Nitza Biologicals Pvt Ltd, Hyd on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2013 for M.Sc Students of Microbiology.

#### **Career guidance & Employability skills :**

“Unemployabilty is today a greater issue than unemployment”. Only 10% of fresh graduates are actually employable with their academic performance, which means that they need to be supplemented with various other skills such as spoken and written English, interpersonal skills, the art of communication, situational behaviour, which play a pivotal role in helping the students fit into the workplace. Lack of these skills may hamper the students' career prospects. Hence the college management decided to train the **final year UG students** on these skills in collaboration with **Zion Cybertech**, Hyderabad. The **department of English** has coordinated for the course in **Employability Skill: Campus to the Corporate Training of duration 45hrs** and signed an **MOU** for the same. This year 400 students benefited from this program which commenced on: **22 August 2013.**
