This year the college has focused more on mentoring, remedial classes and restructuring the academic activities as well as campus placements. Mentoring has been strengthened through rigorous training of teachers, keeping in mind the first generation students and also the students from marginalized section of the society. More initiatives were taken about comprehensive continuous evaluation of students under the remedial programs. Students from all the disciplines were groomed in communication skills and personality development.

**Admissions and Student Strength**

Merit is the benchmark for admitting students. The admission policy of the college is highly transparent and was instrumental in helping many young women from economically weak back ground to avail education here. There is a steady increase in our admissions at the undergraduate level, especially in commerce and computer sciences which has seen about 15% and 20% increase respectively. The strength of the college has grown significantly to 1650 students compared to 1575 in the previous year. However, the admissions in M.Sc. course did not show improvement due to the division of the state and also in part due to the educational policies of newly formed state.

The total intake of students for current academic year 2014-2015 at UG Level is 462, at the PG Level it is 112, and 85 in MBA stream.

## I Q A C – Internal Quality Assessment Cell

The IQAC is in constant search for quality improvement and it has set benchmarks for teaching-learning and examination reforms. In April 2014, it has conducted a series of meetings with departments at various levels and oriented the faculty to prepare the annual plan for 2014-2015. It gave a roadmap to the college for

enhancing the quality and excellence, and suggested various means to strengthen the college in parameters such as:

- Introduction of interdisciplinary papers
- Introduction of life skills programs to UG and PG students
- Bridge course for 1<sup>st</sup> year degree students
- Strengthening remedial programs to reduce failures
- Introducing innovation in teaching methods
- Promote E-learning on the campus and extent use of ICT
- Organizing more pre-placements activities
- Strengthening research and publications
- Enhancing communication skills

### **New Appointments**

10 teachers were recruited through the proper channel in regular posts during this academic year. Sr. Kavitha has been appointed as hostel warden in place Sr. Aruna.

### **Remedial Programmes**

Remedial coaching was conducted every year for the arrear students. Intensive tutorial classes were held, for the students who have backlog papers. This helped many to clear the arrear papers.

### **Interdisciplinary Courses**

To promote integrated learning for successful and challenging careers, inter disciplinary courses were conducted for second and third year students in Web Designing, Medicinal Botany, Nano-technology, Health and Nutrition, Indian Polity and Economy. We have also conducted basic courses in Administration, Organizational Behavior, Basic Mathematics and Biostatistics.

### **Add-on courses**

To go beyond the curriculum and add value to academic programs, the college offered add-on courses of 30-hour duration to the first year UG students in Multimedia, Web Technology, Fabric and Pot Painting, Bakery and Confectionaries. The purpose of these add-on courses is to augment the students' employability.

A 90-hour diploma course in SAP was introduced in August, 2014.

Under Life Skill Program, the college has offered 30-hour certificate course titled 'Grooming for Growth' in Communication Skills in English and Personality Development. I offer my thanks to learners circle for coordinating this course.

### **Capacity Building for Staff**

This year the management sanctioned fee concession for Rs. 5,00,205.00 for 65 deserving students. The state government sanctioned Rs.30,82,545.00 as scholarship for 348 SC, ST, EBC & Minority students in 2013-2014.

### Hostel

The college has attached hostel and students from many states have joined the hostel. It has been provided with all facilities. Security of the inmates is given top priority in the hostel.
